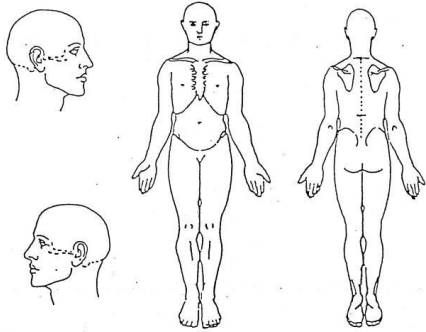
B. **Wie geht's?** Ask how people whom Amal knows are doing. Then ask why they are feeling that way. Don't forget to tell him how you are doing today.

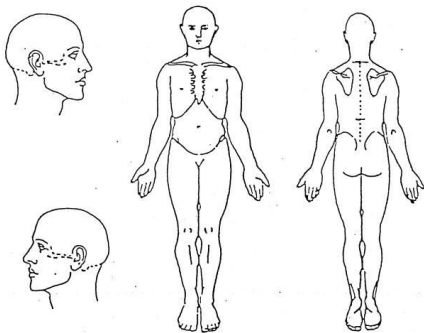

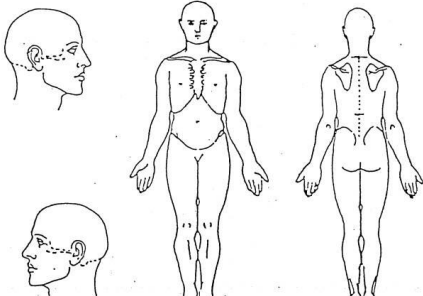

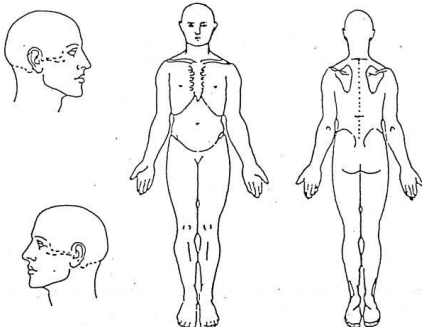
